Best Unpublished Research Paper Award

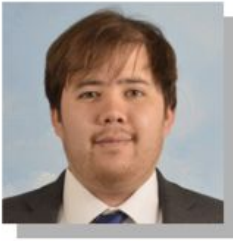

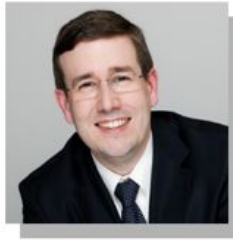

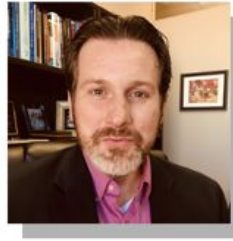
