SCHOLARSHIPS FOR CERTIFICATES IN FAMILY BUSINESS (CFBA) OR FAMILY WEALTH ADVISING (CFWA)



These scholarships provide GEN enrollment and course fees and a one-year individual FFI membership. A complimentary FFI conference registration, during the year of enrollment, is included. Participation in the mentor program is encouraged, but not required.

Established in 2013, this scholarship is for Next-Gen family business members who would like to formalize their learning on the family enterprise.

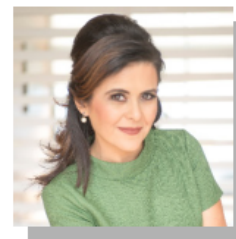
