Esther Kong is co-chair of Asian Circle Virtual Study Group and was the 2019 recipient of the GEN AI Touq Group Scholarship.

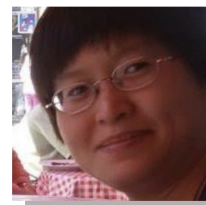

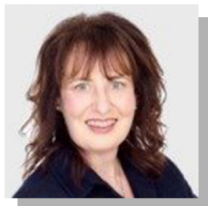
