- ✓ **Behavioral science background as applied to family enterprise**

The Committee is committed to ensuring that the board reflects the global nature of the field and is especially interested in considering candidates with experience researching or advising Asian and MENA family businesses or family offices.

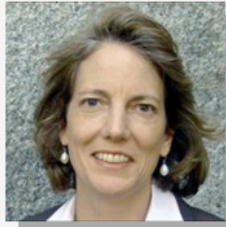
