This year we are pleased to announce that five GEN scholarships are available. There are four scholarships designated for core certificate applicants and one for advanced certificate applicants.

Applications for the 2024 FFI GEN Scholarships are now open and must be received by May 1, 2024. Recipients will be notified by June 15 and may begin their program on July 1, 2024. All certificate program requirements must be completed within one year.

## SCHOLARSHIPS FOR CERTIFICATES IN FAMILY BUSINESS (CFBA) OR FAMILY WEALTH ADVISING (CFWA)

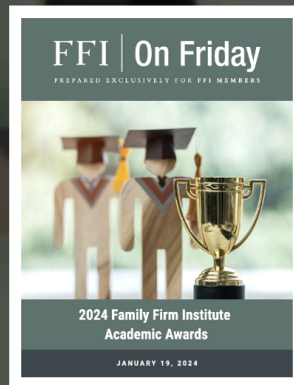
## **NEW DIRECTORY LAUNCH**
