F FI is pleased to offer scholarships for applicants to the Global Education Network (GEN) Core Certificate program. Applications are due May 1, 2025. Recipients may begin their program on July 1, 2025, and will have one year to complete all requirements.

Scholarship Criteria

Scholarships are provided annually for individuals who wish to enroll in a GEN core certificate program.

Scholarships include the following:

- Enrollment fee for the Certificate in Family Business Advising (CFBA) or the Certificate in Family Wealth Advising (CFWA)
- Related GEN courses: GEN 102, 201, 202, 501
- One-year FFI membership
- Complimentary conference registration during the year of enrollment

Applicants are requested to have established credentials in the fields of law, finance, behavioral science, or management science prior to applying for a scholarship. Applicants are encouraged to describe their suitability for one or more of the scholarships described below and to specify which program (CFBA or CFWA) they are applying for.
