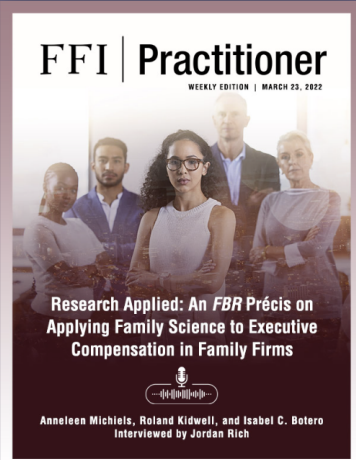

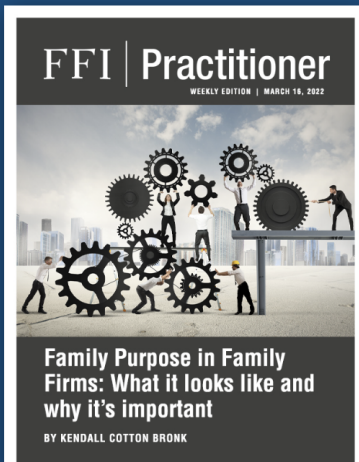
## Research Applied: An *FBR* Précis on Family Firms and Environmental Performance
